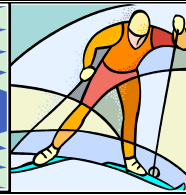
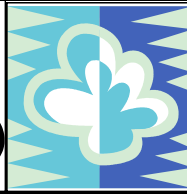
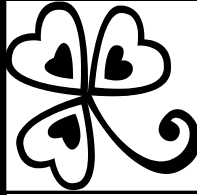

Time: Session 1: 10 am - 11:30 am

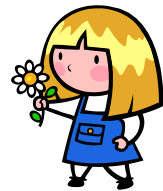
