Position Summary

The Unit Leader is responsible for the health, welfare, development of campers and for teaching and overseeing camp activities.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with children.
- Maturity, good judgment, and ability to deal with emergency situations.
- Must have excellent communication and organizational skills.
- Willing to work as a team member.
- Flexibility, energy, and good sense of humor.
- Outdoor/camping skills and experience.
- Interest in and knowledge of Girl Scout program and *Safety-Wise*.
- Basic swimming ability.
- Minimum age: 21 years old.
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in pre-camp training.
- Coordinate, lead, and supervise all camp programs for assigned Unit based on camp daily schedule.
- Encourage safe and minimal impact camping practices and activities.
- Support and participate in all camp activities.
- Support campers in having fun and adventure while learning new skills.
- Be responsible for camper location and implement buddy system.
- Supervise the campers in unit housekeeping, sanitation, care of supplies, and equipment and cabin inspections.
- Follow all camp policies.
- Be a positive role model for girls.
- Willingness to perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor.
