Position Summary

The Unit Leader is responsible for the health, welfare, development of campers and for teaching and overseeing camp activities.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with children
- Maturity, good judgment and ability to deal with emergency situations
- Must have excellent communication and organizational skills
- Willing to work as a team member
- Flexibility, energy and good sense of humor
- Outdoor/camping skills and experience
- Interest in and knowledge of Girl Scout program and *Safety-Wise*
- Basic swimming ability
- Minimum age: 21 years old
- Current CPR/First Aid Certification
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in mandatory pre-camp training
- Coordinate, lead, and supervise all camp programs for assigned Unit based on camp daily schedule
- Encourage safe and minimal impact camping practices and activities
- Support and participate in all camp activities
- Support campers in having fun and adventure while learning new skills
- Be responsible for camper location and implement buddy system
- Supervise the campers in unit housekeeping, sanitation, care of supplies and equipment and cabin inspections
- Follow all camp policies
- Be a positive role model for girls
- Willingness to perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor
