Mini BOW: Mini Becoming and Outdoor Woman  
Friday, May 18 - Sunday, May 20, 2018

**Mini BOW is based on the Department of Fish & Game's Becoming an Outdoor Woman events, this 2-night, 3-day camp out teaches Girl Scouts valuable outdoor skills through fun and informative skill sessions, taught by trained experts and in a beautiful, remote setting.**

### Here are a few things to know before registering:

- Mini BOW will be held at North Pond, in the Chena Flood Control Project
- Mini BOW is limited to girls who are currently in the Junior grade-level or older
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis with 60 available spots
- Girls can register as a troop or individually for \$75 per girl
- The \$75 fee covers all meals and supplies for the sessions
- The \$75 fee is non-refundable and non-transferrable
- The \$75 fee must be paid in full at the time of registration
- Girls will be assigned to patrols made up of 6-8 girls each
- No RVs or campers allowed, only camping tents
- No electronics of any kind will be allowed, we'll take photos, don't worry!
- There will be no electricity or running water, but there will be porta-potties
- Dietary restrictions cannot be accommodated and girls will be responsible for bringing their own food if needed
- Mini BOW may not be able to accommodate all special needs
- Girls must bring their own tents and sleeping pads & bags, no cots
- Girls cannot be picked up early or dropped off late, except in an emergency
- Vetted and approved volunteers arranged by the Council attend at no cost

### On the day of arrival at Mini BOW:

- Girls will be dropped off at North Pond by 3pm on Friday, May 18th
- Girls will have to carry their gear a short distance (pack accordingly)
- There will be no snacks provided before dinner on Friday night at 5pm
