Position Summary

A Patrol Leader is responsible for the girls' health and welfare within their patrol, ensuring a positive Mini BOW experience.

Qualifications:

- Be a current Registered Adult member of Girl Scouts
- Camping experience
- Willing to work as a team member with other Patrol Leaders
- Flexible, energetic and a good sense of humor
- Listens & follows directions of Mini BOW Director and Staff

Key Responsibilities:

- Be a role model for girls by living by the Girl Scout Law
- Maintain order within the Patrol
- Follow all rules of Mini BOW & make sure that girls follow the same rules
- Follow assigned schedule and get to the sessions prepared and on time
- Make sure girls clean up after themselves
- Support Mini BOW sessions by being respectful of the instructors and help where needed
- Work in an encouraging & positive manner with the grade-level of the girls within the Patrol
- Make sure girls have all required materials and supplies
- Attend all required Patrol Leader trainings
- Learn and understand all Mini BOW emergency procedures
- Practice Leave No Trace camping etiquette
- Model respectful & positive behavior with other Patrols, instructors & staff
