- Listen, follow directions, and work in collaboration with Mini BOW Director and Staff

Key Responsibilities:

- Be a role model for girls by living by the Girl Scout Law
- Maintain order within the Patrol
- Follow all rules of Mini BOW & make sure that girls follow the same rules
- Follow assigned schedule and get to the sessions prepared and on time as well as respect bedtime rules
- Make sure girls clean up after themselves throughout the weekend
- Support Mini BOW sessions by being respectful of the instructors and help where needed
- Work in an encouraging & positive manner with the grade-level of the girls within the Patrol
- Make sure girls have all required materials and supplies
- Attend all required Patrol Leader trainings
- Learn and understand all Mini BOW emergency procedures
- Practice Leave No Trace camping etiquette
- Model respectful & positive behavior with other Patrols, instructors & staff
